

Point & Shoot - Terms & Conditions

Eligibility

1. Point & Shoot is open to all Australian veterans. An Australian veteran is defined as a person who has served in the Australian Defence Force for at least one day in either a regular or reserve capacity.
2. This event also encourages the commemoration of veterans no longer here. We invite families to share the experiences of their loved ones unable to tell and share their own stories.
3. The veteran must be either the image artist or subject.

Consent

4. In submitting an image for consideration in Point & Shoot you are consenting to:
 - Being an Australian veteran
 - Being either the image artist or subject of the image
 - Allowing Point Assist to seek approval from Defence Imagery to publicly display the image
 - Potential use of imagery by Point & Shoot event partner, RSL Queensland
 - Donation of any printed exhibit images to the Point & Shoot Gallery
(a collection of imagery from annual exhibits displayed on a rotating basis at Point Assist Training Facility and used as part of roving promotional activities for this exhibit)
5. All images including other Defence personnel must be accompanied with each person's individual consent for the image to be displayed along with the image submission to be eligible for consideration.

Categories

6. There are no specific categories for Point & Shoot. All images will be shortlisted based on their individual merits including accompanying stories.

Digital Manipulation

7. You can adjust 'photographic' variables such as exposure, contrast, colour, noise and sharpness. Lens and perspective corrections, cropping and black-and-white conversions are also accepted.
8. Cloning to remove distractions or add new elements to your image is not allowed.
9. Point Assist reserves the right to disqualify an image if they feel it lacks authenticity due to over-manipulation.
10. Images must be 100% photographic in origin. The use of stock images is forbidden.

Copyright

11. All imagery taken by or of Defence personnel during their military service remains under copyright of the Department of Defence.
12. By submitting an image, the entrant provides Point Assist the consent to seek clearance from Defence media to publicly display the image.
13. All decisions by Defence media are final and not open to appeal.

14. Images will be credited with the name of the photographer or remain anonymous at the entrant's request.
15. Imagery is not permitted to be shared for monetary gain.

Image Requirements

16. Image format: Images must be in JPEG (.jpg) format.
17. Image file size: Individual images must be no larger than 5MB.
18. Images should not include watermarks or other branding.

Shortlisting

19. Entries will be shortlisted by the exhibit organisers and staff of Point Assist.
20. Shortlisting decisions are final and not open to appeal.

Submission Announcement

21. Images selected for exhibit will be notified via email upon conclusion of shortlisting.

Closing Date

22. Submissions close Sunday 28 May 2023 (11:59pm, AEST).

General

23. The entrant indemnifies Point Assist Pty Ltd (ABN 61 147 513 184) against any claim, legal or otherwise, that may arise out of the display of images.
24. By submitting an image for consideration the entrant guarantees to Point Assist Pty Ltd that all of the above Terms and Conditions have been met. Any entry found to breach the above Terms and Conditions will be ineligible for display.
25. Post event, all printed display images will form part of the Point & Shoot Gallery, a collection of images from annual exhibits displayed on a rotating basis at Point Assist Training Facility in Tasmania and used as part of roving promotional activities for this exhibit.
